Vice Admiral Michael S. Rogers has served his country in uniform for over thirty years and is currently the Navy's senior operational authority in the areas of cyber, networks, cryptology and signals intelligence, electronic warfare, space, and information operations as Commander U.S. Fleet Cyber Command/Commander U.S. TENTH Fleet.
